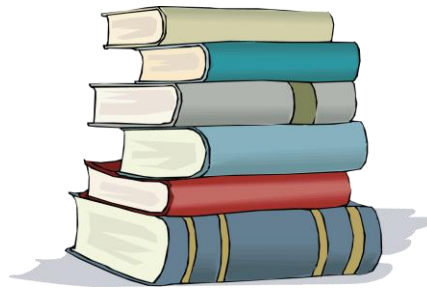
April Trivia: Who was the first general officer on either the Union or Confederate side, to die on the battlefield?
